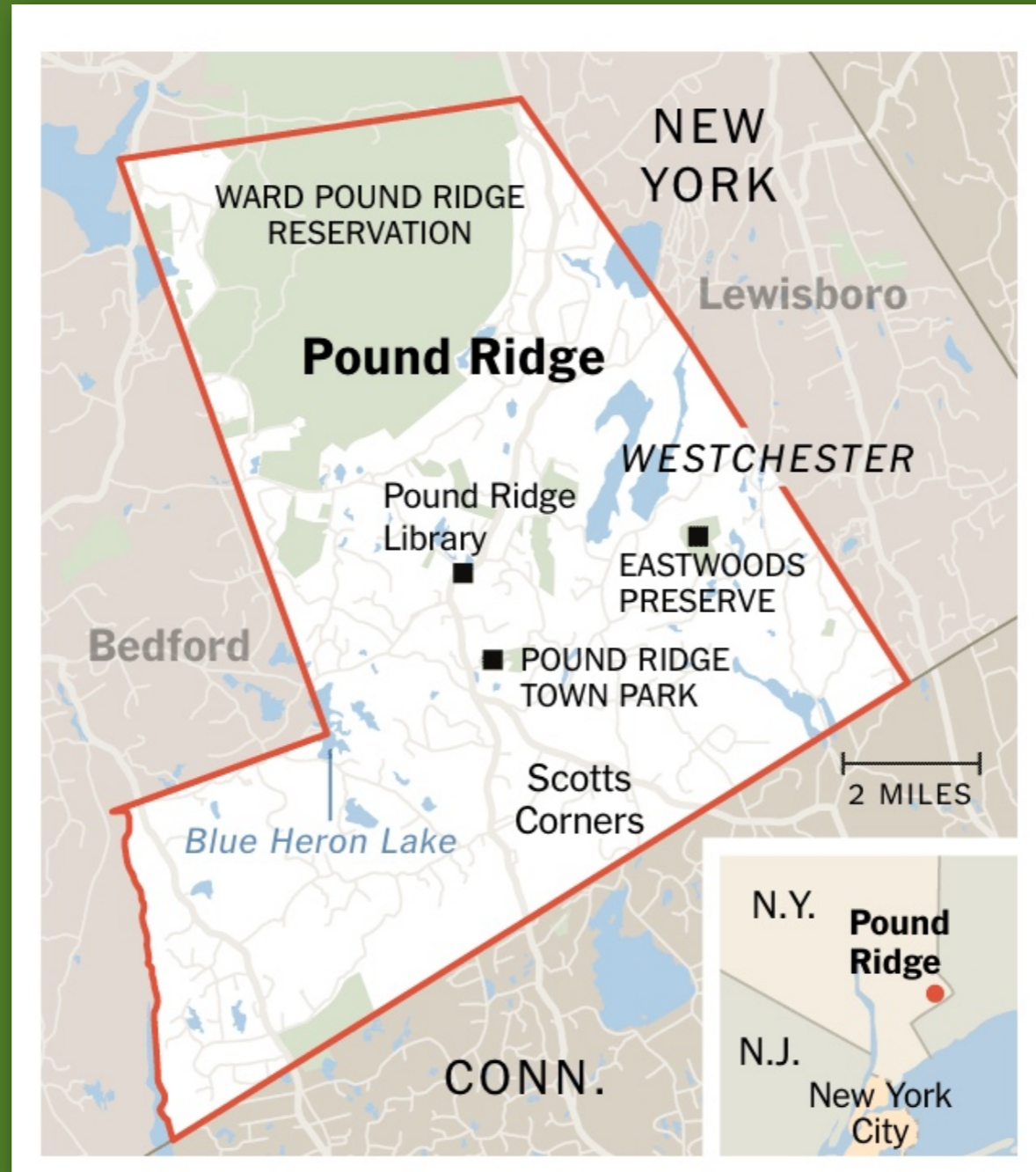

WHAT IS IT LIKE

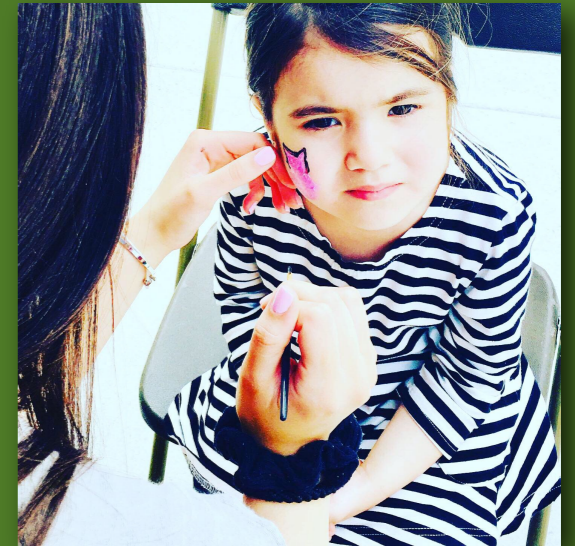
COUNTRY LIFE CLOSE TO THE CITY

- Approximately 50 miles from New York City
- Characterized by bucolic roads that wind around wooded slopes, streams, lakes and 19th century stone walls
- 30 square miles
- Iconic street signs designed in the 1950's by local artist/designer Guy Rainsford point the way home
- No traffic lights or public transportation
- About 1930 single family homes, no rental complexes



WHO LIVES IN POUND RIDGE'S 30 SQUARE MILES

- Population estimated at 5,153 as of July 2018
- 54.5% Females
- 1,978 households avg 2.63 persons per household
- 75.5% of persons 25+ have Bachelor's degree or higher
- 55.5% population aged 25-64, 22.5% are 65+
- 75.5% have Bachelors Degree or higher
- 94.2% employed in white collar jobs
