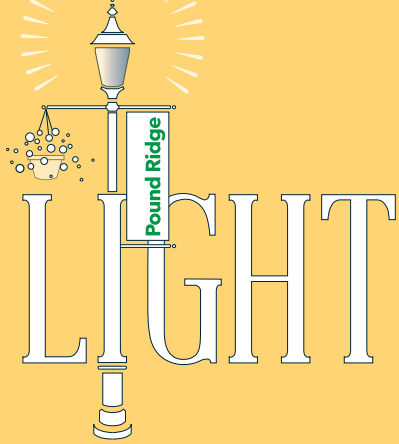


# ADOPT A STREET

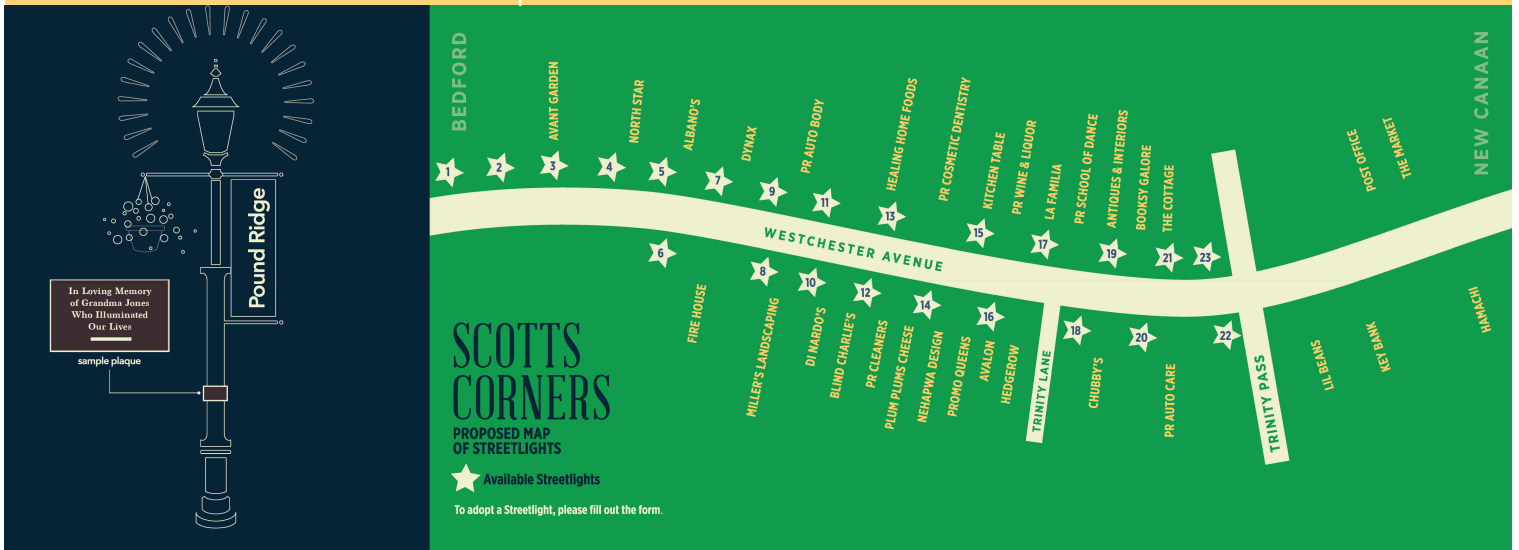


## What is the Adopt-A-Streetlight Program?

Adopt-A-Streetlight program offers an opportunity for your business, family or loved one to be recognized while supporting the enhancement of our community through the installation of environmentally friendly street and parking lot lights in the Scotts Corners Business District in Pound Ridge, NY.

The goal of the project is to increase the energy efficiency of the lighting infrastructure in the Scotts Corners Business District while contributing to the beautification and revitalization of the area. More efficient street lighting technologies save energy, reduce green house gas emissions, cost less to operate and maintain, have a longer life and provide better visibility, lighting more evenly with natural color rendition.

The streetlights in Pound Ridge, installed in 1993, need to be replaced because they are in poor condition and are not energy efficient. New streetlights will not only make Pound Ridge more environmentally friendly but will greatly enhance the safety and beauty of our main business street.



## How Can I Participate?

For a donation of \$5,000, business owners, groups, families, and individuals can adopt a streetlight acknowledged by an engraved brass plaque to be affixed to the streetlight. Donations can also be made in honor of someone, anonymously, or otherwise. You can also arrange to share the costs with other families. For example, five families or groups can adopt a streetlight together (\$1,000 per family, one line of text per family). Please submit one application for the entire group. Alternatively, for \$1,000 we can offer you one line of text on a plaque with others. If you pre-arrange in advance and submit one application, you will be able to choose who you are with on the plaque.

Donations are tax deductible.



### SPONSORED BY THE POUND RIDGE GREEN STREETS COMMITTEE

The Green Streets Committee (a collaboration of the Pound Ridge Partnership and the Pound Ridge Business Association) initiated the project to install new, LED, environmentally friendly streetlights in the business district. As a consequence of this initial work, Pound Ridge received the TEP (Transportation Enhancement Program) grant, so streetlights on Westchester Avenue will be installed as part of that project. The Green Streets Committee will be funding additional streetlights along with the next phase of their plan, illuminating the parking lots.
